SCHOLARSHIP

The Greyhound Hall of Fame will award a \$1,000 scholarship at its Spring Meet. The purpose of the scholarship program is to encourage post high school education to persons connected with the sport of Greyhound racing.

The Scholarship winner will be announced in early April and recognized at the National Greyhound Association Spring Meet. The scholarship recipient will receive \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester.

The student must be in good standing and provide a tran-

script of the fall semester to receive the second payment.

The recipient will be selected by a panel of independent judges based solely on the application forms and the three recommendations.
